Experience the food, music, dance, religion and history of Ghana! During this travel study course, students will travel through Ghana, learning the Mfantse language, visiting tribal Chiefs and National Parks. Students will spend time in Accra, Cape Coast, Obuasi, Kumasi, Tamale, Mole and Akosombo. The program will combine participation in cultural activities, travel to relevant sites with local language learning and formal seminar presentations on topics designed to bring students closer to an understanding of Ghana's cultural, historical and technological heritage and reality. Participants will provide oral presentations on structured, experiential topics, and a term paper.
