UVM In Ghana: A Discovery Program

Instructors: Prof. Daniel Bentil (UVM) & Prof. Naana Opoku-Agyemang (Ghana)
May 20 - June 5, 2009



Experience the food, music, dance, religion and history of Ghana! During this travel study course, students will travel through Ghana, learning the Mfantse language, visiting tribal Chiefs and National Parks. Students will spend time in Accra, Cape Coast, Komenda, Kumasi, Akosombo, Tamale, and Mole. The program will combine participation in cultural activities, 3-day homestay, travel to relevant sites with local language learning and formal presentations on topics designed to bring students closer to an understanding of Ghanaian culture, heritage and reality. Oral and written presentations on structured research topics will be required of participants.

Program Fee: \$1,970; Airfare: \$1,500 (Approx.) and Tuition: 3 or 6 Credits.
